

Matti Öhman

1945 – 2008

The managing director and founder of Mica Elektro Oy Ltd, Matti Öhman, passed away on Saturday 15.3.2008 after a grave illness. He founded his company in 1983 and worked as both the managing director and chairman of the board for 25 years. He leaves behind a wife and daughter.

Engineer Matti Öhman was born in Oulu in 1945, but spent his early life and studies in Helsinki. He graduated as an engineer in 1970 and during his studies, he held the position of chairperson of the students' union. In his leisure time, he was an enthusiastic boater and spent a lot of time at his island cabin on Ristiina. The members of Finland's Sauna Society remember Matti as an anxious sauna goer and he also acquainted many of his international business partners with the sauna. As an employer, Matti was assertive and greatly respected by his personnel. Changes in personnel in Mica Elektro have always been very small.

In addition to the work of his founded company, Matti Öhman contributed to many societies and other positions of confidence. In 1998, he sold Insmat Oy, who he founded in 1989, to the investment company Bergman & Beving AB. Some years ago, Matti Öhman sold close to half of the share capitals of Mica Elektro Oy to its personnel.

Mica Elektro Oy has over 20 employees and has a subsidiary company in St Petersburg.

The position of managing director of Mica Elektro Oy Ltd will now be held by Åke Smolander. He has been in the service of the company for close to 20 years and has earlier held the posts of sales director and assistant managing director.
